**“By faith Moses...was hidden for three months by his parents (vs. 23).”**

**“By faith Moses...refused to be called the son of Pharaoh’s daughter  
(vs. 24).”**

**“By faith the walls of Jericho fell down after they had been encircled  
for seven days (vs. 30).”**

**“By faith Rahab the harlot did not perish...  
after she had welcomed the spies in peace  
(vs. 31).”**
