

THE PARABLE OF THE SOWER

1. The wayside soil (Matthew 13:4)

A beaten ground where the seed is not going to grow

2. The rocky soil (Matthew 13:5-6)

Another ground where it is difficult to grow seed

3. The thorny soil (Matthew 13:7)

Ground where the crop is choked out and becomes unfruitful

4. The good soil (Matthew 13:8)

Ground that produces the crop that the sower intended

The Meaning (Matthew 13:18-23)

1. The seed is God's word (vs. 19).
2. The sower is the teacher (Mark 4:14).
3. The soils represent people's hearts (vs. 19).

1. The wayside soil (Matthew 13:19)?

This person chooses to reject the word of God.

2. The rocky soil (Matthew 13:20-21)?

This person is converted but falls away.

3. The thorny soil (Matthew 13:22)?

This person brings forth no fruit.

4. The good soil (Matthew 13:23)?

This person holds to the word and bears fruit for God.

Only the good soil is saved!
