

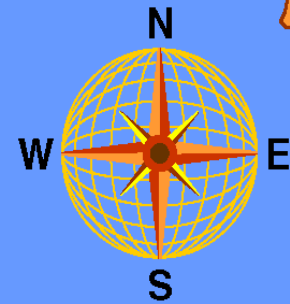

- **After spending some time back in Antioch, Paul traveled through Galatia and Phrygia (Acts 18:23).**

- **Paul taught them about Jesus. He also baptized them in the name of Jesus and laid hands on them (Acts 19:4-7).**

- **After the riot ceased, Paul went north 200 miles to Troas. He had hoped to hear news of the Corinthians from Titus (2 Corinthians 2:12-13).**
- **From there he traveled 180 miles to Philippi. Here Titus brought word to him of the Corinthians (2 Corinthians 7:2-7; Acts 20:1).**

- **Acts 20:4 provides a list of men who brought money from the various churches.**

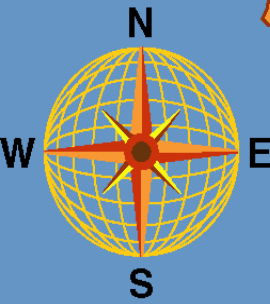

- **Acts 20:6 marks the beginning of Paul's trip to Jerusalem.**

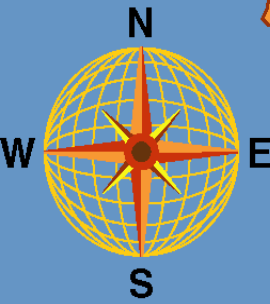
