# The Gursing of the Fig Tree 

The breba should have been there!

- The common fig tree produces two kinds of fruit each year: the breba and the standard fig.



## The Gursing of the Fig Tree

The breba should have been there!

- The Breba always comes first (March and April). It grows when the tree is putting out its leaves (when it is not the season for figs).



# The Gursing of the Fig Tree 

The breba should have been there!

- It is edible but often ignored.
- When it doesn't grow, the standard figs won't either!

- Since the tree had leaved out, the breba should have been there.
- Since it wasn't, that means this was a fruitless tree!
