Jesus Versus the Religious Leaders (Tuesday)

- In the morning, the apostles noticed the withered fig tree.
- Once they arrived at the temple, Jesus began to teach. The chief priests and elders challenged His authority. Jesus' silenced them by asking about the baptism of John.
- The Herodians then came to Him with a question about taxes.
- The Sadducees then came to Him with a question about the resurrection.

- A scribe then asked Him a question about the greatest commandment.
- Jesus posed a question to the Pharisees. The question had to do with David's connection to the Christ.
- After this, no one asked Him any more questions.

- Several parables are taught in the temple condemning the religious leaders.

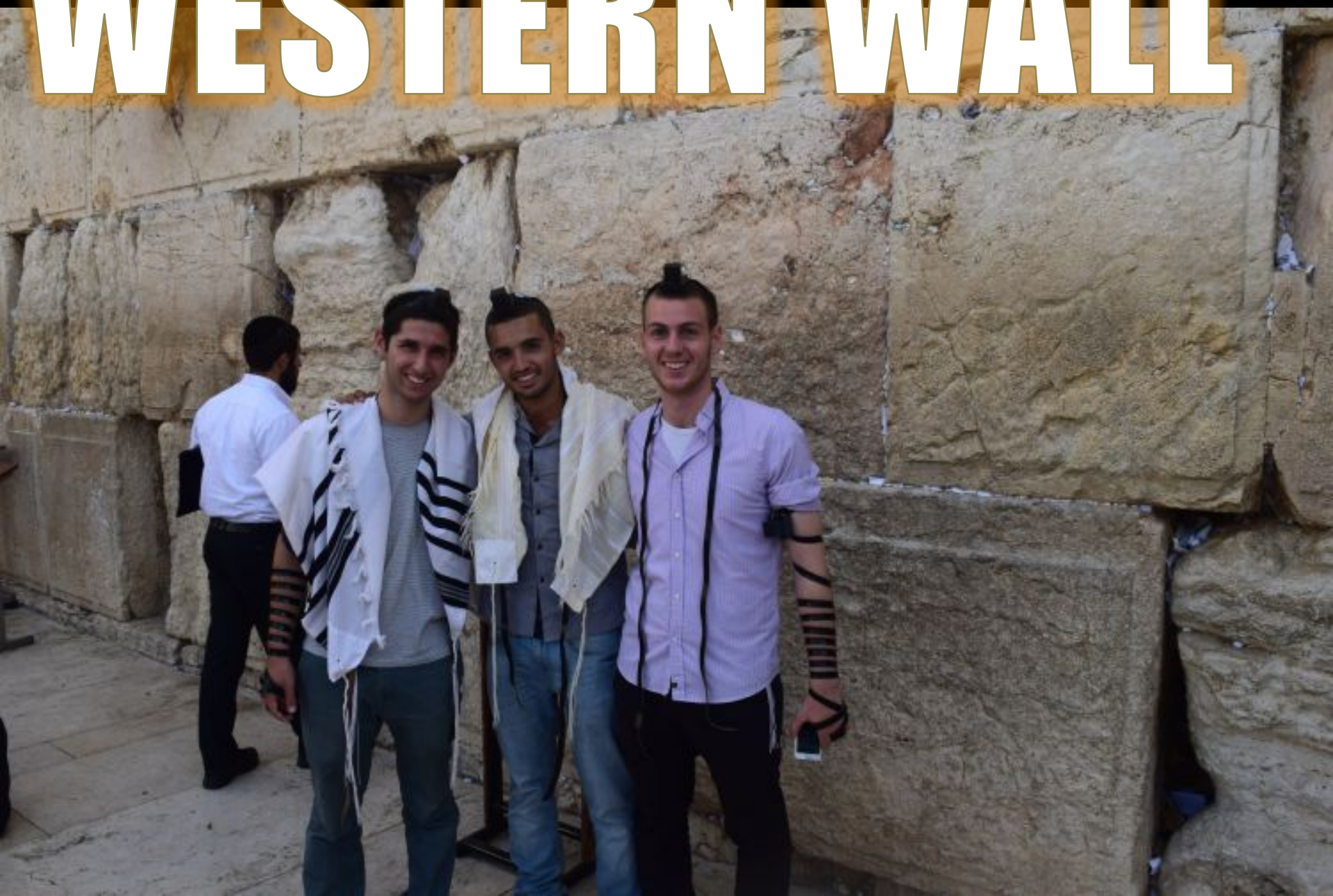


Jesus Versus the Religious Leaders (Tuesday)

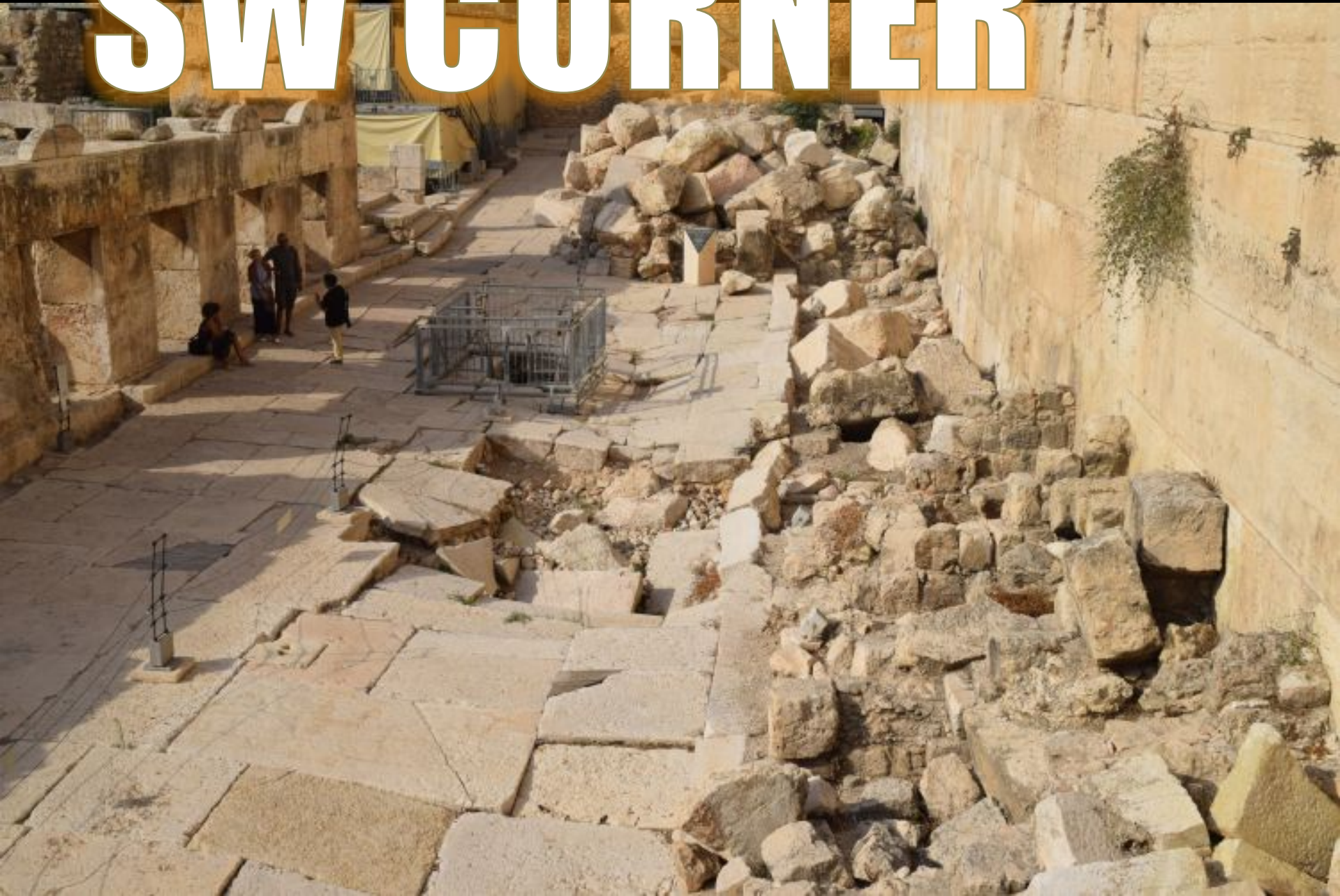
