The women arrive at the tomb early on Sunday morning (Mark 16:1-4)



Mary Magdalene runs off to fetch Peter and John (John 20:1-2).

The other women enter the tomb and talk to the angel (Mark 16:5-8).

Jesus appears to women disciples (Matthew 28:8-10).

Peter and John enter the tomb (John 20:3-10).

Jesus appears to Mary Magdalene (John 20:11-18).

The disciples disbelieve (Luke 24:10-12).

Jesus appears to Peter (Luke 24:34).

Jesus appears to two disciples on the road to Emmaus (Luke 24:13-35).

Jesus appears in an upper room (John 20:19-20).

- Jesus received two reactions upon entering the city.

- Since the fig tree was fruitless, Jesus cursed it.
- Jesus cleansed the temple.

Tuesday

- Jesus spent much of the day teaching in the temple.
- Jesus was challenged by the Herodians,
 Sadducees, scribes, and Pharisees.
- Jesus publicly rebuked the Pharisees.
- Jesus foretold the destruction of Jerusalem.

Wednesday

- We don't know exactly what the Lord did on this day.
- The chief priests and elders began plotting to kill Jesus.
- Judas offered them an opportunity to gain access to Jesus in private.
- Judas accepted thirty pieces of silver for his help.

Thursday

- Jesus prepared and ate the Passover with His disciples.
- Jesus gave them good and bad news.
- After praying, Jesus was betrayed and arrested in the garden.
- Jesus appeared before the high priests.

Friday

- Jesus appeared before Pilate and Herod.
- Pilate handed the Lord over to be crucified in Golgotha.
- Jesus hung on the cross for six hours.
- After Jesus died, His body was placed in a tomb owned by Joseph.

Sunday

- Jesus was raised early in the morning.
- The disciples were not expecting Him to be raised.
- Jesus began making several appearances to His disciples.
- The enemies attempted to cover up the resurrection.
