# Thursday Night

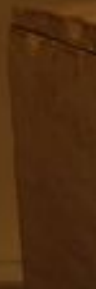

## What happened with Judas?

- He gave the money back.
- The leaders used the money to purchase a field to bury strangers (Field of Blood).
- Judas committed suicide.
- Judas' body would later burst open in this field.

# Scourging

- A whip with a handle and metal lashes was used.
- The victim's flesh was often torn (revealing internal organs).
- Many would die from these beatings.
- This is probably why Jesus couldn't carry His cross to Golgotha.

## Other Observations

- Since He wasn't the Messiah they wanted, the religious leaders charged Jesus with the very thing they had been waiting for!
- Jesus experienced ill treatment and humiliation by the hands of Roman soldiers.
- The Jews took responsibility for killing Jesus.
- Simon was forced to carry Jesus' cross.
