A. The resurrection of Jesus is crucial to our hope: 1 Corinthians 15:14-19

- If Christ is not risen, our faith is vain!
- If Christ is not risen, we are still held guilty for our sins, no forgiveness has occurred!
- If Christ is not risen, those who died as Christians are lost!
- If Christ has not risen, then we do not have a "living" hope and should be pitied!
