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- Is it the Holy Spirit baptism (Matthew 3:11)?
- Is it the baptism of Jesus (Matthew 3:13-17)?





The one baptism is for those who believe the gospel (Mark 16:15-16).



> The one baptism is for those willing to repent and confess Jesus as Lord (Acts 2:38; 8:37).



The one baptism is to be administered by disciples (Matthew 28:19-20).



> The one baptism is for the remission of sins (Acts 2:38; Romans 6:4).



Through the one baptism we are saved and made disciples (Matthew 28:19; 1 Peter 3:21).



Through the one baptism the saved are added to the one church (Acts 2:47; Ephesians 1:22-23; 4:4)



Through the one baptism we have our sins washed away and call upon the name of the Lord (Acts 22:16).
