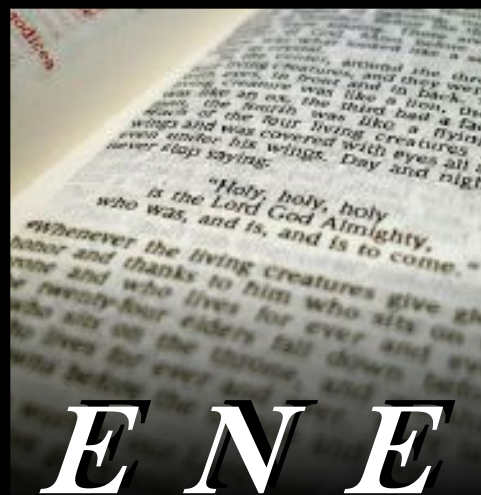

6. Verse 7: These angels received authority to execute God's wrath!
7. Verses 8: The time of repentance was up!
