THE STORY OF REVELATION The seven seals tell us the basic story!

The seven trumpets represent God's warning.

The seven bowls represent God's full judgment!



THE SERIES OF SEVEN!

- 1. God commands the pouring out of seven bowls (vs. 1).
- 2. These are seven bowls of wrath (vs. 1).
- 3. The first 4 bowls seem to have to do with natural calamities (vss. 2-9).
- 4. God's judgments are declared "righteous and true" (vss. 5-7).
- 5. God avenges His people in His time (vss. 5-7).
- 6. The wicked still refused to repent after the pouring out of the first 4 bowls (vss. 8-10).

- 7. Pharaoh also refused to repent after receiving natural calamities (Exodus 7:22; 8:15, 32; 9:7).
- 8. When the 5th bowl is poured out the beast's kingdom becomes darkened and men experience much pain (Revelation 16:10-11). Maybe this represents this widespread evil and corruptness throughout the empire. Regardless, the wicked still refused to repent!
- 9. When the 6th bowl is poured out, an army from the east comes through the dried up Euphrates (vs. 12).


