II. Breaking Down the Text

A. Hebrews 9:1-10

1. Why do you think the writer refers to the "Tent" or "Tabernacles" rather than the "Temple"?
2. What was the layout of the earthly Tabernacle as described in verses 2-5.
3. What was the service to God offered by the priests in the earthly Tabernacle described in verses 6-7.
4. What do verses 9-10 show about the regulations in the Tabernacle?

B. Hebrews 9:11-15

1. Describe Jesus' tabernacle. How is it better than the earthly tabernacle?
2. What was the blood of bulls and goats able to do? What was Jesus' blood able to do?

C. Hebrews 9:16-28

1. Why does blood inaugurate a covenant (a testament)?
2. How was the the first covenant and earthly Tabernacle dedicated according to the writer?
3. How did Jesus dedicate the new covenant?
4. How is the new covenant clearly better than the old when considering these things?
5. What will happen for those who persevere and eagerly wait for Jesus?
