# THREE QUESTIONS (HEB 3:16-19)

- Who having heard, rebelled?
- With who was He angry forty years?
- Who did He swear would not enter His rest?

All who came out of Egypt, led by Moses Those who sinned, whose corpses fell Those who did not obey

# So we see that they could not enter in because of unbelief

#### BELIEF IS ESSENTIAL

#### • **BELIEF**

- In God's word, promises, and ability to aid us
- Compare Heb 3:19 and 4:2, 6, 11
- Where does BELIEF originate?
  - Hearing the Gospel (good news) Heb 4:2
- What does this BELIEF prompt?
  - Obedience and trust Heb 4:2

#### GOD'S REST

- "rest" is mentioned in Heb 3:11,18, 4:1,3,4,5,8,9,10,11
- What comes to mind when you define "rest"?
- What would the Hebrews likely use to define rest?
- Since God's rest is connected to the Israelites failure to take Canaan, is God's rest a place?
- When is God's rest first mentioned of in the Bible?

# GOD'S REST IN HEB 4:1-11

- Promise of entering remains (v1)
- Fear lest you fall short (v1)
- Requires faith (v2)
- For we who have believed <u>do</u> enter that rest (v3)
- Finished from foundation of world (v3)
- God's seventh day rest is connected (v4,10)
- Some must enter (v5)
- Disobedience kept Israelites from entering (v6)
- Can be entered "today" (v7)
- Was not given by Joshua (v8)
- Remains for the people of God (v9)
- Requires diligence to enter (v11)

### GOD'S REST IS OPEN NOW!

- Heb 4:1a Therefore, since a promise remains of entering His rest, let us fear lest any of you seem to have come short of it.
- Heb 4:3a For we who have believed <u>do enter</u> that rest
- **Heb 4:9** There <u>remains</u> therefore a rest for the people of God
- Heb 4:11 Let us therefore <u>be diligent to enter</u> that rest

### GOD'S REST PROVIDES:

- Our true needs
- Freedom from primary focus on physical needs
- Freedom from sin's oppression and slavery
- Peace
- A focus on fellowship with God
- Worship, appreciation, and adoration to God
- Contentment
