GOD'S REST PROVIDES:

- Our true needs
- Freedom from primary focus on physical needs
- Freedom from sin's oppression and slavery
- Peace
- A focus on fellowship with God
- Worship, appreciation, and adoration to God
- Contentment

We experience "God's rest" NOW through Jesus

GOD'S WORD REVEALS ALL HEB 4:12-13

- The Word of God is:
 - Living
 - Powerful
 - Sharper
 - Piercing
 - Discerning
- Nothing is Hidden from God
- We are Naked and Open to God

HEBREW 5: HIGH PRIEST DUTIES

- Every High Priest offers gifts/sacrifices for sin.
 - Appointed by God
 - Numbers 3:10
 - Intercessor for men (Link--Mediator)
 - <u>See 2:17</u>

Offers:

- Gifts—Voluntary (Freewill Offerings)
- Sacrifices— Mandatory for sins/offenses

- High Priest was sensitive to the problems of the people he represented.
 - He also had weaknesses/sins!
 - Weakness: lack of strength; frail; limited power;
- See **Chapter 4: 14-16** (JESUS).
- Ignorantly go astray:
 - Misled; mistaken; deceived;
 - God sees the Heart! (Ch.4: 12-13)
 - What's the difference???
- Deliberate/Intentional/Willful Sin
 - Hardened heart

- **Hebrews Challenge**: Persecution
 - Renew their commitment
 - Remain faithful
 - Hearts become hardened— Ch.6:4-6)
- Mosaical System Problem:
 - The High Priest was a sinner!
 - See (Leviticus 4: 3-12)
- Roman Rule: High Priest became a political post

- Jesus: Our Great High Priest
 - "You are My Son, today I have begotten You."
- Jesus: is the reason that we are saved. (5:9-10).
 - Greater than angels
 - Greater than Moses
 - Greater than Mosaical High Priest
- "You are a priest after the order of Melchizedek."
 - Psalm 110:4
 - Combines the offices of both High Priest AND King!

HEBREW 5: LESSONS FOR US

- King Saul: Tried to combine the two (1 Sam.13:8-14)
- Uzziah: (2 Chron.26:16-21)
- Melchizedek: Priest after the order of;
 - See Chapter 7:14
 - No Successor
 - Directly appointed by God
 - Sole office holder
 - At God's right hand: Entered into the Most Holy Place

Jesus is a better High Priest:

- Appointed by God
- · He had no sin.
- He has lived as we have.
- He learned obedience. (Humbled Himself—(Phil. 2:5)
- He is both High Priest and King.
- He has entered into the Most Holy Place.
