- CHAPTER 6 -

HOPE IS THE ANCHOR OF THE SOUL

THE CHRISTIAN WHO FALLS AWAY HEBREWS 6:4-6

- The initial state of the Christian
 - Enlightened
 - Tasted the heavenly gift
 - Partakers of the Holy Spirit
 - Tasted the good word of God
 - Tasted the powers of the age to come
- Were these people truly converted? YES
 - But they fell away.

THE CHRISTIAN WHO FALLS AWAY HEBREWS 6:4-6

- The final state of the Christian
 - Fallen away
 - Crucify again for themselves the Son of God
 - Put the Son of God to open shame
- How is this Christian similar to the Israelites who wandered 40 years (Heb 3:12)?
- It is impossible...to renew them again to repentance"
 - What does the parable of prodigal son in Luke 15 teach us about this principle?

AN ILLUSTRATION HEBREWS 6:7-8

Fruitful Ground

- Drinks the frequent rain
- Bears useful herbs
- Cultivated
- Receives blessing from God

Unfruitful Ground

- Thorns and briars
- Rejected
- Near to being cursed
- End is to be burned

Jesus' gave a similar parable. Which one?

WE ARE CONFIDENT OF BETTER THINGS CONCERNING YOU (HEB 6:9-12)

PREVIOUS CHARACTER

- Workers for God
- Love for His name
- Served the Saints
- Still Serving

FUTURE CHARACTER

- Imitate the faithful
- Imitate the patient
- Inherit God's promises
- Not lazy or sluggish

What must they eliminate in order to achieve this?

When difficulty arrives, what must we do to persevere in faith?

GOD'S PROMISES ARE SURE HEB 6:13-18

- God's promise to Abraham was "doubly sure"
 - God's Word
 - God's Oath
- Abraham's example
 - Patient endurance
 - Obtained God's promise
- The Hebrews were heirs of Abraham, but in a more important way than bloodline. How?
- V.18 we have strong consolation, who have fled for refuge to lay hold of the hope set before us.

HOPE IS OUR ANCHOR (HEB 6:19-20)

• "This hope we have as an anchor of the soul, both sure and steadfast, and which enters the presence behind the veil, where the forerunner has entered for us, even Jesus,"

 "having become High Priest forever according to the order of Melchizedek."
