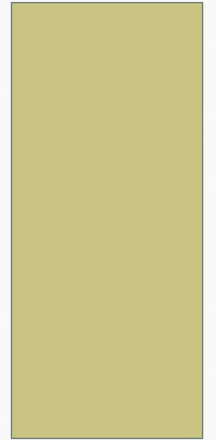

THEREFORE...

(HEB 10:19-25)

Premises “We Have”

- We have **boldness** to enter the Holy Place by Jesus' blood (19)
- We have a great **High Priest** over the house of God (21)

Conclusion – “Let us”

- Let us **draw near** in full assurance of faith (22)
- Let us **hold fast** the confession of hope (23)
- Let us consider how to **stir up** love and good works in each other (24)

THE ASSEMBLY

HEBREWS 10:25

And let us consider one another in order to stir up love and good works, not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together, as is the manner of some, but exhorting one another, and so much the more as you see the Day approaching.

Exercise:

- 1) What do we *give* when we assemble?
- 2) What do we *get*?

WHAT DAY IS APPROACHING?

- The day of judgement?
 - (1 Cor 1:7-8)
- The day of persecution?
 - (Psa 20:1)
- The day we are mature in the faith?
 - (2 Pet 2:19)

THE ALTERNATIVE TO DRAWING NEAR

HEB 10:26-31

If we sin willfully after receiving knowledge of the truth

- A sacrifice no longer remains (26)
- Fearful expectation of terrible judgement (27)
- Worse punishment than prescribed by Moses (28-9)
- Vengeance and judgement from God (30)

**“It is a fearful thing to fall into the hands
of the living God.”**

RECALL THE FORMER DAYS

HEB 10:32-36

- What are they asked to recall?
 - Past struggles and suffering
 - Reproach and tribulation they had endured
 - Companionship with the mistreated
 - Compassion shown for the jailed writer of Hebrews
 - Acceptance of plundering of their goods
- What qualities would allow them to receive God's promise?
 - Stay confident
 - Endurance

WE DO NOT DRAW BACK

HEB 10:37-39

“For yet a little while, And He who is coming will come and will not tarry.

Now the just shall live by faith;

But if anyone draws back, My soul has no pleasure in him.”

But **we** are not of those who draw back to perdition, but of those who believe to the saving of the soul.
