JESUS SERVES AS A BETTER HIGH PRIEST IN THE TRUE TABERNACLE

HEBREW 9: EARTHLY TABERNACLE

Shadow/Model/Copy

- Earthly; Temporary; tent;
- Sacred Objects Inside—Gone! (1 Kings 8.4).
- Holy Place: (First Place in Tabernacle)
 - Lampstand (Rev.4.5)
 - The Table of Showbread (Ex.25:27-30).
 - Showbread (Lv.24:5 ff).
- Most Holy Place: (Lv.18:7). Day of Atonement Only.
 - Golden Censer
 - Ark of the Covenant
 - Golden Pot: Contained Manna; Aaron's Rod; Stone Tablets;

- Most Holy Place:
 - Incense burnt via golden censor
 - Symbolized the prayers of His people. (Rev.5:8; Psa.141:2; 1 Chron.28:2.
 - Off-limits to all—except High Priest (One Day per Year)
 - Day of Atonement /Yom Kippur
- Gold Pot of Manna (God's care for them).
- Aaron's Rod that Budded (Affirmed Aaron's Priesthood).
 - The Covenant and the Priesthood went together.
- Tables of <u>Stone</u>: Summary of entire Law (Heb.10:28)
- MHP: Josephus in 1st Century: "There is nothing in it."
- See Jeremiah 3:16---

- 2 Cherubs: Facing each other in MHP
- O.T: one approached God thru earthly items which were temporary/copies of Heavenly
 - Disappear when the Messianic order established!
- Bottom Line: Chapters 9 and 10
 - Better Sacrifice
 - Better Blood
 - New Covenant

<u>Daily/Activities</u>

- Lampstand (7 branched
 - Lit at night
 - Extinguished during the day
 - Wicks were trimmed for proper length
 - Filled with Oil (Ex.30:7ff)

One per Week---Sabbath Day

- Loaves of Showbread replaced with new loaves
- Priests ate the old loaves (Lev.24:5-9)

HEBREW 9:

Once per Year: (Defective in it's very nature)

- H.P. entered MHP
- Took blood of a bull and a goat
- Lv.16—H.P. offered blood of bull for himself
- Offered a goat for sins of the people
- Sprinkle the blood of bull on Mercy Seat for himself
- Go back outside---slaughter the goat
- Go back into MHP—sprinkle blood on Mercy Seat for people.

• Jesus is a better High Priest:

- Appointed by God
- He had no sin.
- He has lived as we have.
- He learned obedience. (Humbled Himself—(Phil. 2:5)
- He is both High Priest and King.
- He has entered into the Most Holy Place.
