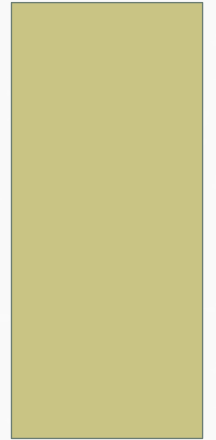

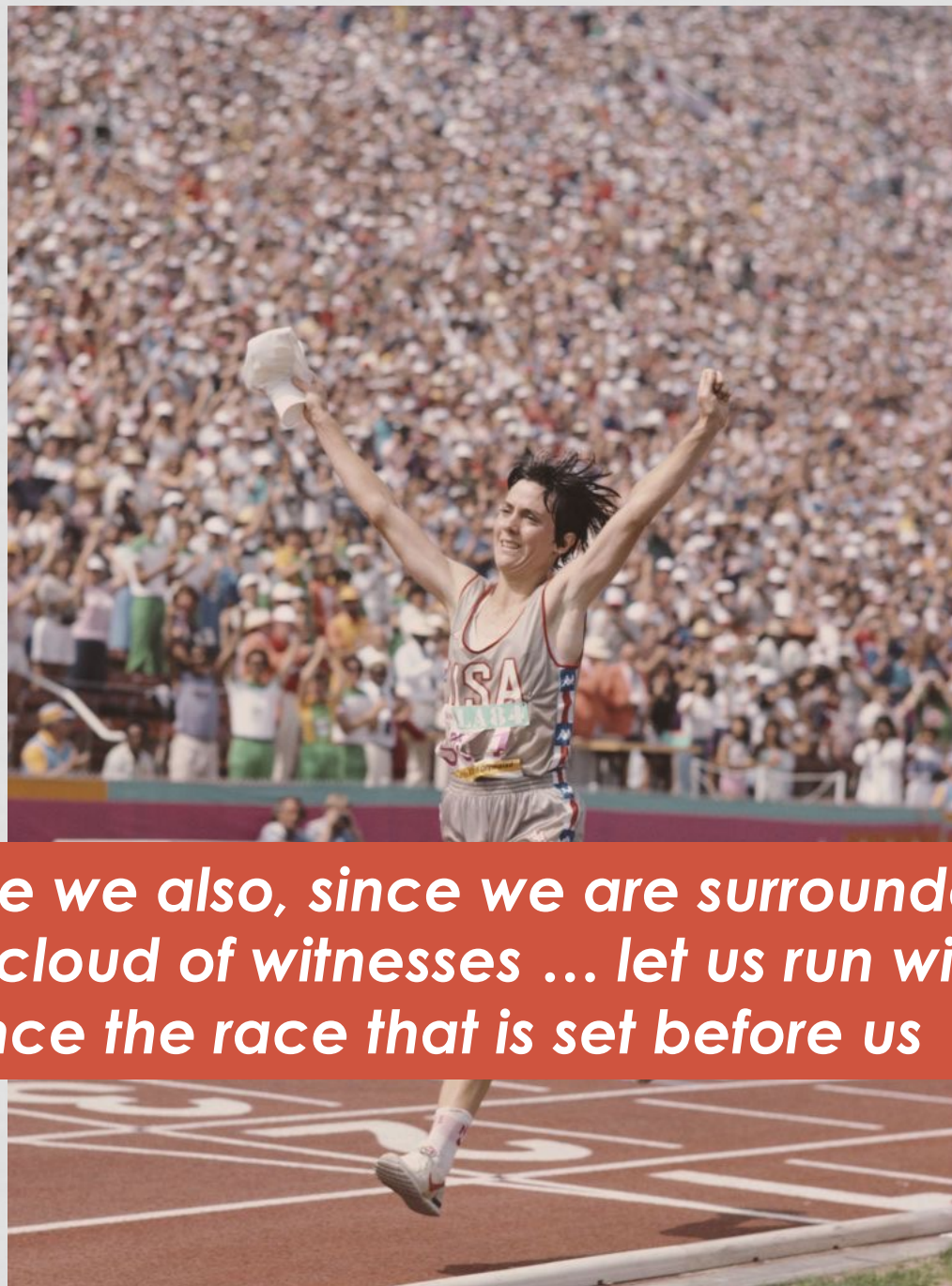

- Strove against sin to point of His death
