
RUN WITH ENDURANCE - NEVER GIVE UP

GOD CHASTENS THOSE HE LOVES HEB 12:5-11

- Why is it so hard? Why do we have to endure?
 - Chastening is how God refines and train us to endure
- Why does the Lord chasten (train)?
 - Because He loves us and He wants us to endure
- What does Hebrews call those who do not receive chastening ?
 - Illegitimate children
- Is chastening joyful as it occurs? What is the end result?
 - Chastening is hard BUT yields "peaceable fruits of righteousness

Therefore strengthen the hands which hang down, and the feeble knees, and make straight paths for your feet, so that what is lame may not be dislocated, but rather be healed. Heb 12:12-13

At Sinai (Exodus)

- Fire on mountain (19:16-18)
- Loud sound (19:19)
- The Law given (Chs 20-31)
- A false god worshipped (ch 32)
- God's anger proclaimed (32:10)
- Covenant broken (32:19)
- 3000 died (32:28)

At Zion (Acts 2)

- Tongues of fire (2:3)
- Loud sound (2:2)
- The Gospel given (2:22-36)
- Jesus recognized as Lord (2:36)
- God's love proclaimed (2:39)
- Covenant entered (2:41)
- 3000 saved (2:41)

What distinguishes those who died at Sinai from those who were saved at Mt. Zion?

HEAR GOD'S VOICE HEB 12:25-29

- Do not refuse Him who speaks
 - What lesson does Hebrew writer say christians should take from Mt Sinai?
