

A cappella (/aː kəˈpɛlə/, also UK: /æ -/, Italian: [a kap'pɛlla]; Italian for "in the manner of the chapel") (sometimes spelled "a capella" from Latin) music is group or solo singing without instrumental accompaniment, or a piece intended to be performed in this way.
