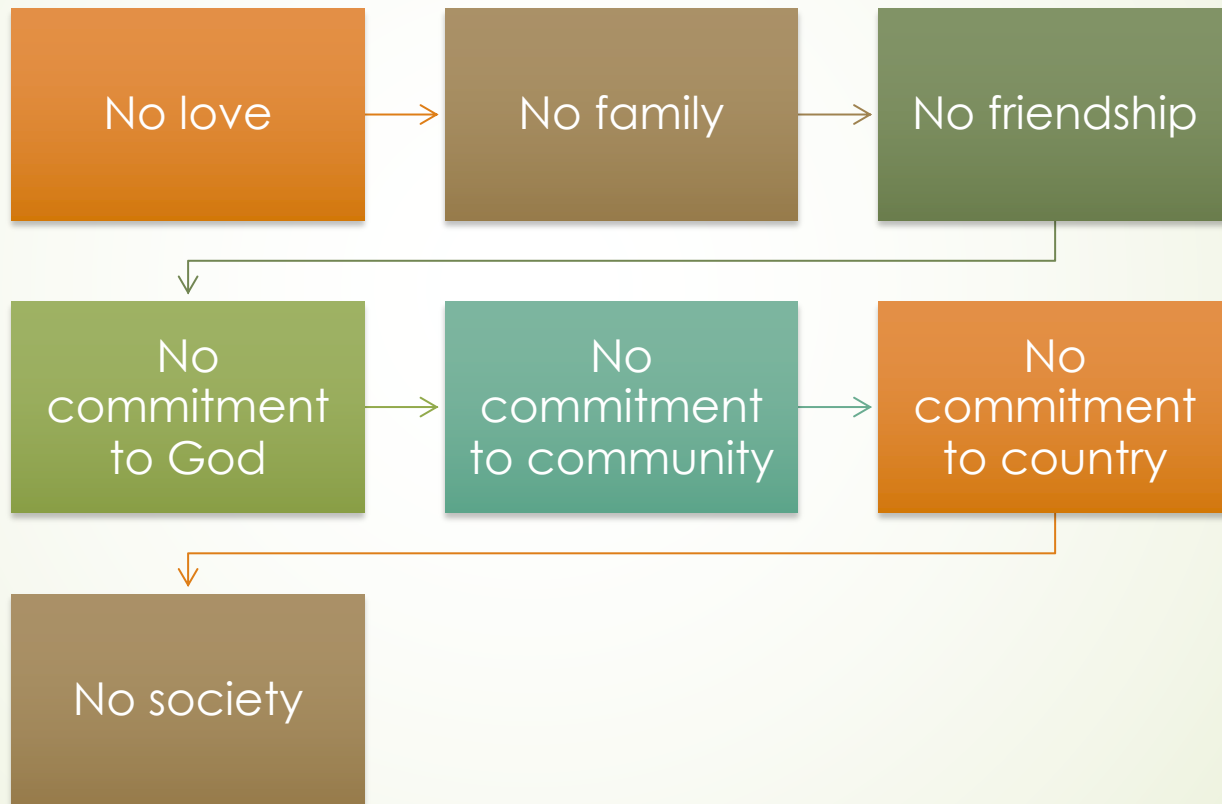
A significant ingredient for a good character
