
Significance of 7, Especially Within Revelation

"I know that after my departure fierce wolves will come in among you, not sparing the flock; and from among your own selves will arise men speaking twisted things, to draw away the disciples after them." Acts 20:29-30

"...remain at Ephesus so that you may charge certain persons not to teach any different doctrine."

I Timothy 1:3

This is actually why Timothy was told to stay in Ephesus. Paul wanted someone there to protect the church from false teaching.

"...some have made shipwreck of their faith, among whom are Hymenaeus and Alexander, whom I have handed over to Satan that they may learn not to blaspheme." This wasn't just a problem for the future, but it was happening even during Paul and Timothy's time around Ephesus.
