• Love takes the initiative. o God "first loved us" − I John 4 • God not only took the first step, He did so while we were weak, ungodly, sinners, enemies (Rom. 5). • If you need to reconcile with someone, LOVE THEM, by taking the initiative. • Example of Hosea marrying Gomer.
