
#### Paul's Prayer For The Philippians


## Knowledge Without Love




"Real Knowledge" (epi-ginosko) — The word is intensified by "epi" to suggest a full, special, precise and correct knowledge.

"Discernment" (aisthesis) – Suggests a keen discernment of sensitive moral perceptions and ethical matters – 2 Timothy 3:15

#### "...In Order To Be..." What?

"...sincere and blameless until the day of Christ;..."

Sincere (Eili-krines) – "<u>judged by the heat of the</u> <u>sun</u>" – The idea of "<u>purity</u>" is inherent in the term.

Blameless (a-pro-skopos) – "not stumbling oneself or causing someone else to stumble because of you."

#### How Important Is This Principle?

It was the final straw that resulted in Judah being taken away into Babylonian Captivity!

Leviticus 10:10 "...and so as to make a distinction between the holy and the profane, and between the unclean and the clean..." NASU

Jeremiah 5:30-31 "An appalling and horrible thing Has happened in the land: 31 The prophets prophesy falsely, And the priests rule on their own authority; And My people love it so! But what will you do at the end of it?

#### How Important Is This Principle?


Ezekiel 22:26-27 "Her priests have done violence to My law and have profaned My holy things; they have made no distinction between the holy and the profane, and they have not taught the difference between the unclean and the clean; and they hide their eyes from My sabbaths, and I am profaned among them. NASU

Ezekiel 44:23-24 "Moreover, they shall teach My people the difference between the holy and the profane, and cause them to discern between the unclean and the clean." NASU
