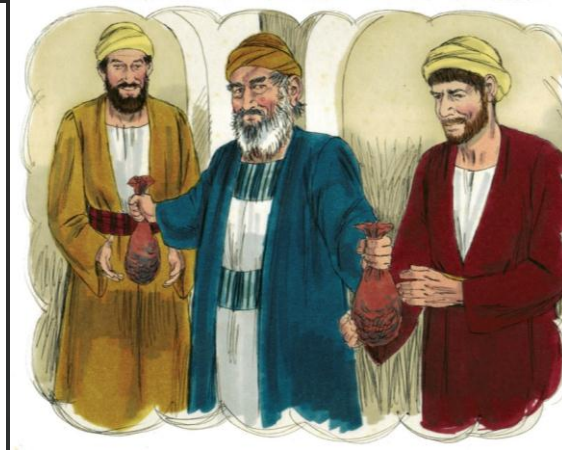
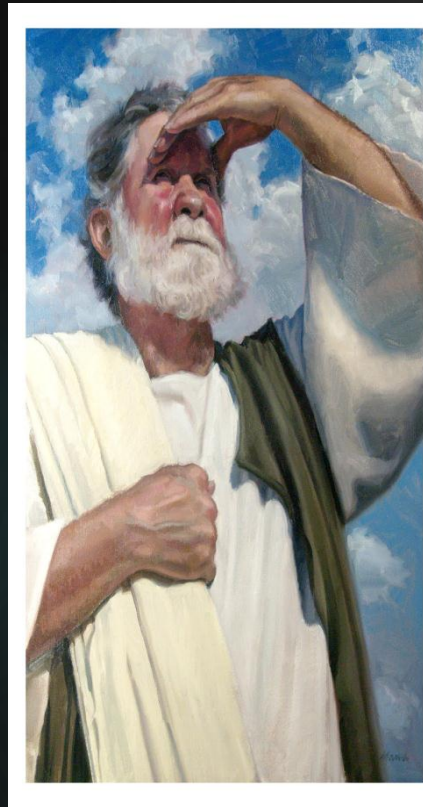

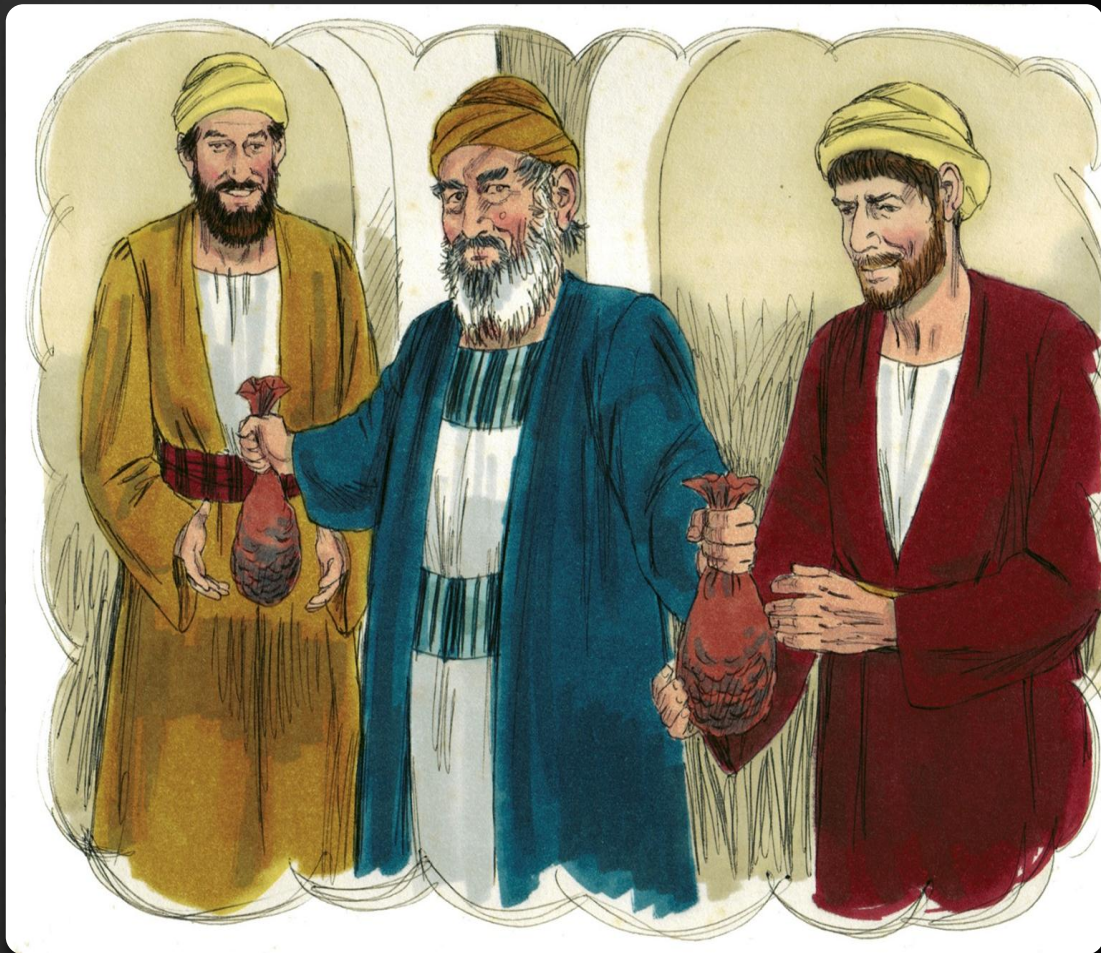

Romans 8:17

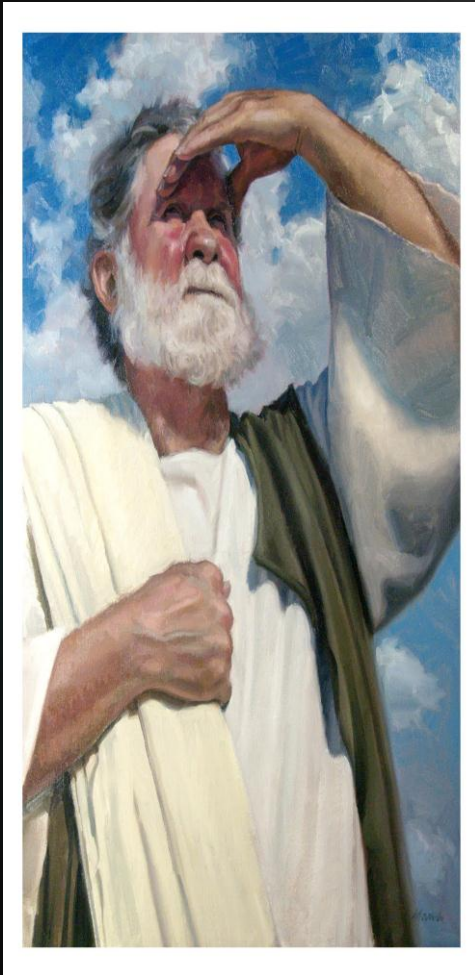
“...and if children, then joint-heirs of God and fellow heirs with Christ...”

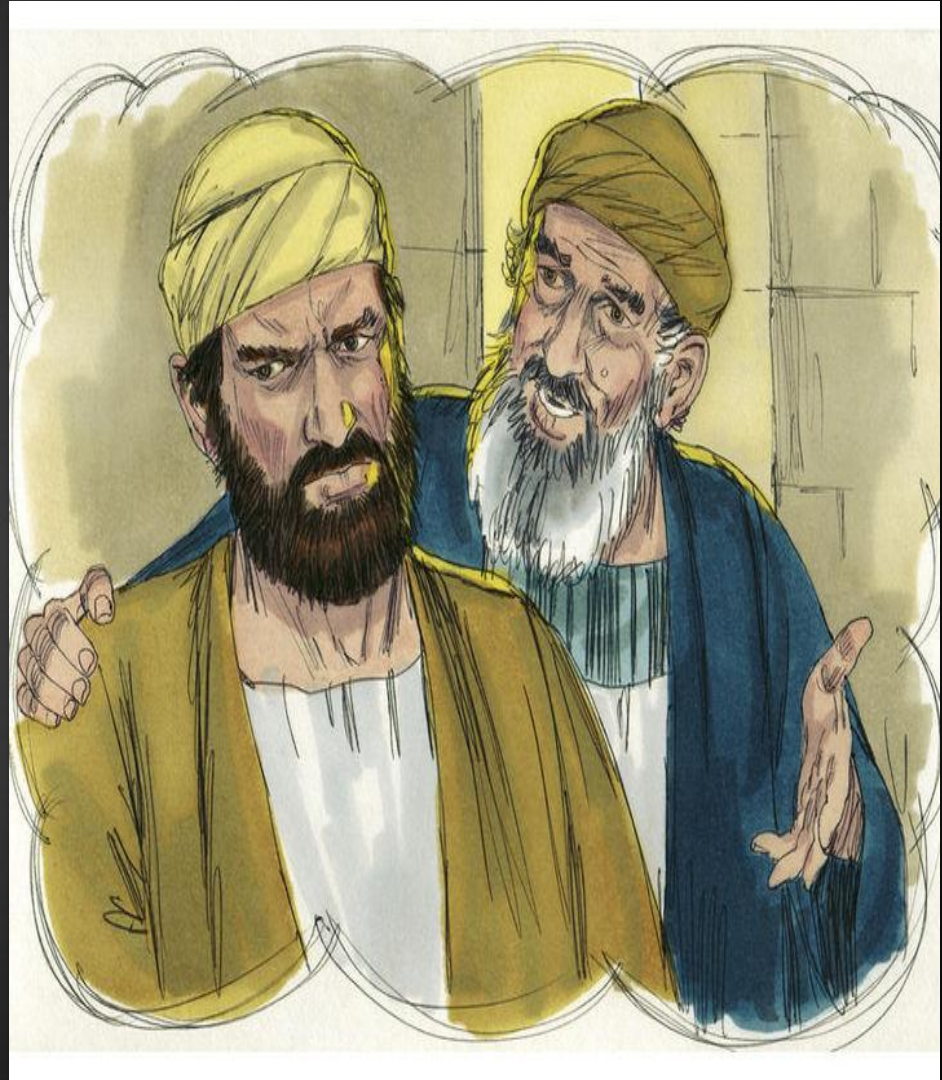
