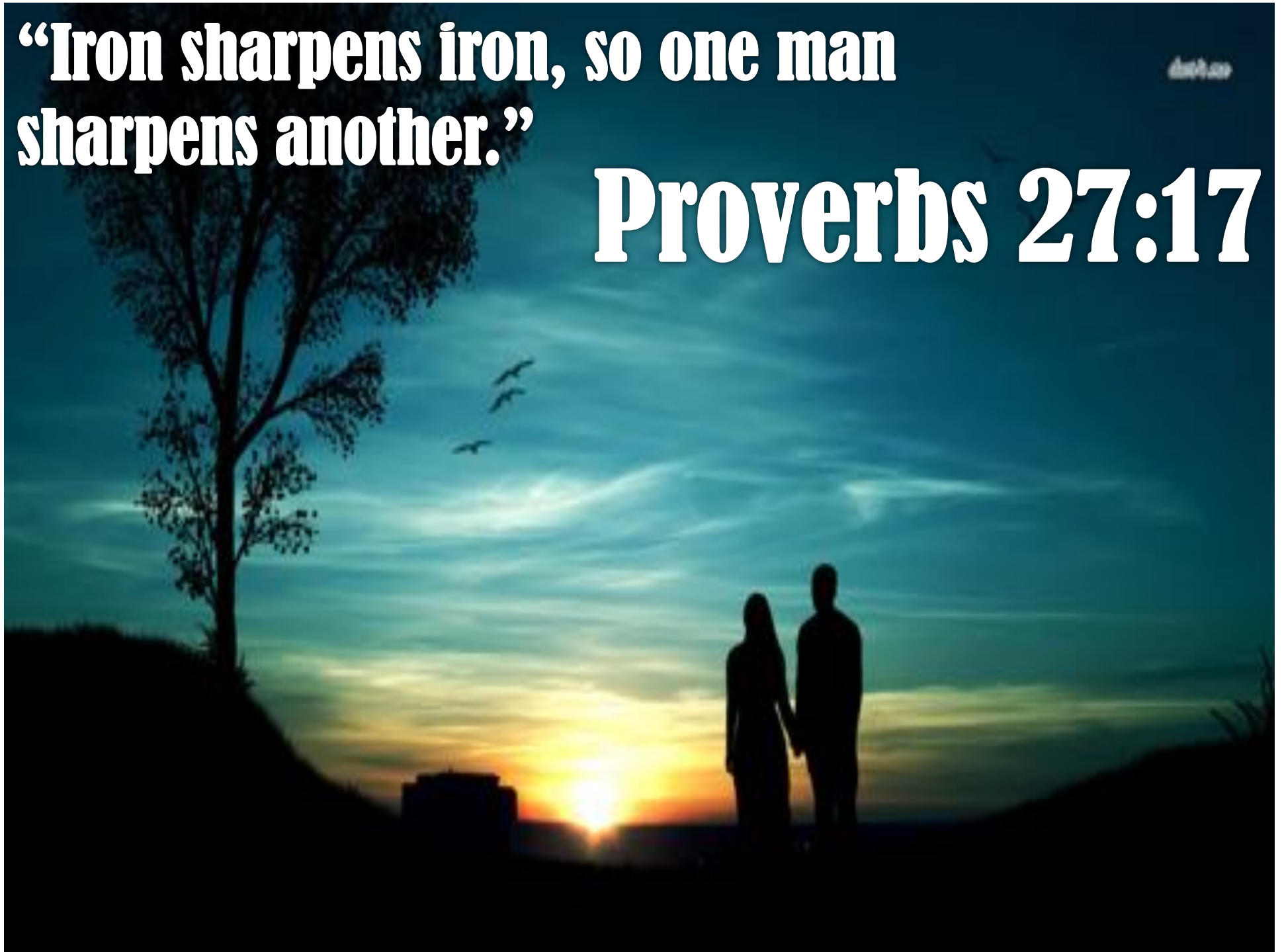


# Transparency
