


## THE GODHEAD

THE WORD "GODHEAD" IS MENTIONED THREE TIMES IN THE BIBLE (ACTS 17:29, ROMANS 1:20, COLOSSIANS 2:9). EACH PERSON OF THE GODHEAD IS MENTIONED, SPECIFICALLY, IN MATTHEW 28:19, SPEAKING OF BAPTIZING INDIVIDUALS IN THE NAMES OF THE FATHER, SON, AND HOLY SPIRIT, AND ALSO IN EPHESIANS 2:18, ROMANS 15:30, 2 CORINTHIANS 13:14, EPHESIANS 4:4-6, 1 PETER 1:2, HEBREWS 9:14, JUDE 20-21 AND MOST OF 1 JOHN 5.





## FATHER-SON RELATIONSHIP

- JESUS IS THE EMBODIMENT OF EVERYTHING THAT IT MEANS TO ESSENTIALLY BE GOD (COLOSSIANS 2:9). HE IS ONE IN THE CREATIVE FORCE WITH GOD (COLOSSIANS 1:14-17).
- THE SON AND THE FATHER ARE ONE IN THEIR WORKS (JOHN 5:17-19). THERE IS PERFECT UNITY BETWEEN THEM.
- JOHN 9:4, 10:37-38, AND 5:36 ALSO ILLUSTRATE THE WAY JESUS CHRIST ONLY DID WHAT THE FATHER APPROVED OF. THEY ARE ONE.



## WHO IS THE HOLY SPIRIT?

- HE IS GOD, JUST AS MUCH AS THE SON OR THE FATHER. 2
  CORINTHIANS 3:17 MAKES THIS MORE THAN CLEAR.
- HE SHARES ALL OF THE ATTRIBUTES OF GOD WITH THE OTHER MEMBERS OF THE GODHEAD:
  - HE IS ETERNAL (HEBREWS 9:14)
  - HE IS OMNIPRESENT (PSALM 139:7-10)
  - HE IS OMNISCIENT (1 CORINTHIANS 2:10-11)
  - HE IS OMNIPOTENT (PSALM 104:30, LUKE 4:18, ETC.)
