


THE NAMES OF THE FEAST

- Feast of Ingathering
 - The gathering in of laborers and their work.
- Feast of Booths/Tabernacles
 - Comes from Hebrew word "sukkah", which literally is, "hut woven from boughs".
 - We often use the word tent to capture the idea, but it's all about it being a temporary dwelling.
 - They were to live in them 7 days to re-enact how the Israelites lived after coming out of Egypt.
