#### **James 4:13-15**

- 15 "Come now, ye that say, Today or tomorrow we will go into such a city, and continue there a year, and buy and sell, and get gain:
- 14 Whereas ye know not what shall be on the morrow. For what is your life? It is even a vapour, that appeareth for a little time, and then vanisheth away.
- 15 For that ye ought to say, If the Lord will, we shall live, and do this, or that."

# What Guarantees Do We Have in Life?

#### Saying:

## There's only 2 things Guaranteed in Life:

- 1) Death
- 2) Taxes



Matt. 17:24-27 → "Does you Master pay the Census Tax?"

vss. 25-26 → Jesus explains:

"Taxes are NOT taken from the King's children"

vs. 27 → the fish you catch will have a shekel in its mouth.



#### I. The Guarantee of Death

A. Physical Death

Job 14:1-2 → Man's days are few, and full of trouble

Ecclesiates 12:7 → Man shall return to dust

Hebrews 9:27 → an appointment with Death

**Death: An Unavoidable and Inevitable Reality** 

**Question:** Do we have to FEAR Death?

The Answer depends on ME!!

#### I. The Guarantee of Death (Cont.)

**B. Another Death Guarantee : Death of the Old Man** 

Rom. 6:1-11 → Dead to Sin; Alive unto God

**Ephes 4:17-24** → Put Off the Old Man; Put on the New

Col. 2:13 → We are Dead to Sin; Alive unto God


⇒ If we obey God, the Old Man is put to Death

II Cor. 5:14-19 → In Christ, All things are New



### II. The Guarantee of the Opportunity of Being Saved

Eccles. 9:4 → "...a living dog is better than a dead Lion"



Isaiah 55:6-7 → "Seek the Lord while He may be found"



#### II. The Guarantee of Salvation's Opportunity

#### A. Salvation was not Always Available to All Men

Matt.10:5-6 → Not for Gentiles

Matt. 15:22-24 → Jesus' response to the Canaanite Woman

#### All this changed after Jesus' death on the Cross

**Matt. 28:19-20** → "...teach all nations"

Ephes. 2:11-19 → all men united in Christ

Mark 16:15-16 → "...He that believeth and is baptized"

#### II. The Opportunity of Salvation (Cont.)

#### **B. Salvation with a Guarantee**

**Ephes.1:11-14** → Holy Spirit: Our Earnest

⇒ Legal Terms, just like a house loan

Num. 23:19 → "God is not a man, that He should lie"

Ephes. 1:14 → "[The Holy Spirit,] which is the earnest of our inheritance until the redemption of the purchased possession"



#### II. The Opportunity of Salvation (Cont.)

B. Salvation with a Guarantee (Cont.)

#### **Ephes.1:14**:

- a) <u>KJV</u>: "the earnest of our inheritance, until the redemption of the purchased possession."...
- b) ASV: "an earnest of our inheritance, until the redemption...
- c) <u>Weymouth</u>: "a pledge and foretaste of our inheritance, in anticipation of its full redemption...
- d) Nuovo Diodati: "il quale è la garanzia della nostra eredità, in vista della piena redenzione dell'acquistata proprietà

#### III. A Guarantee that You'll Always be Loved

John 3:16 → "For God so loved the world, that He gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in Him should not perish, but have everlasting life."

#### III. A Guarantee that You'll Always be Loved

A. God "so" Loved the World

"so" ⇒ a 2-letter word

John 3:16 → "For God so loved the world ..."

**⇒** God loved the world so much that . . .

**Rom. 5:6-11** → (especially vs. 8)

John 15:13 → "Greater love hath no man than this, that a man lay down his life for his friends."

#### III. A Guarantee that You'll Always be Loved

#### B. God can Love you NO Matter What !!!

2005, Reba McEntire: "You're Gonna Be"

<u>Luke 22:31-32</u> → Peter informs Peter of Satan's request

<u>Luke 22:56,58,59</u> → Peter denies Christ three times

<u>Luke 22:61-62</u> → Jesus looks upon Peter

John 21:15 → Jesus speaks with Peter, coming back from fishing

⇒ No matter what we do, Jesus can love & forgive us
