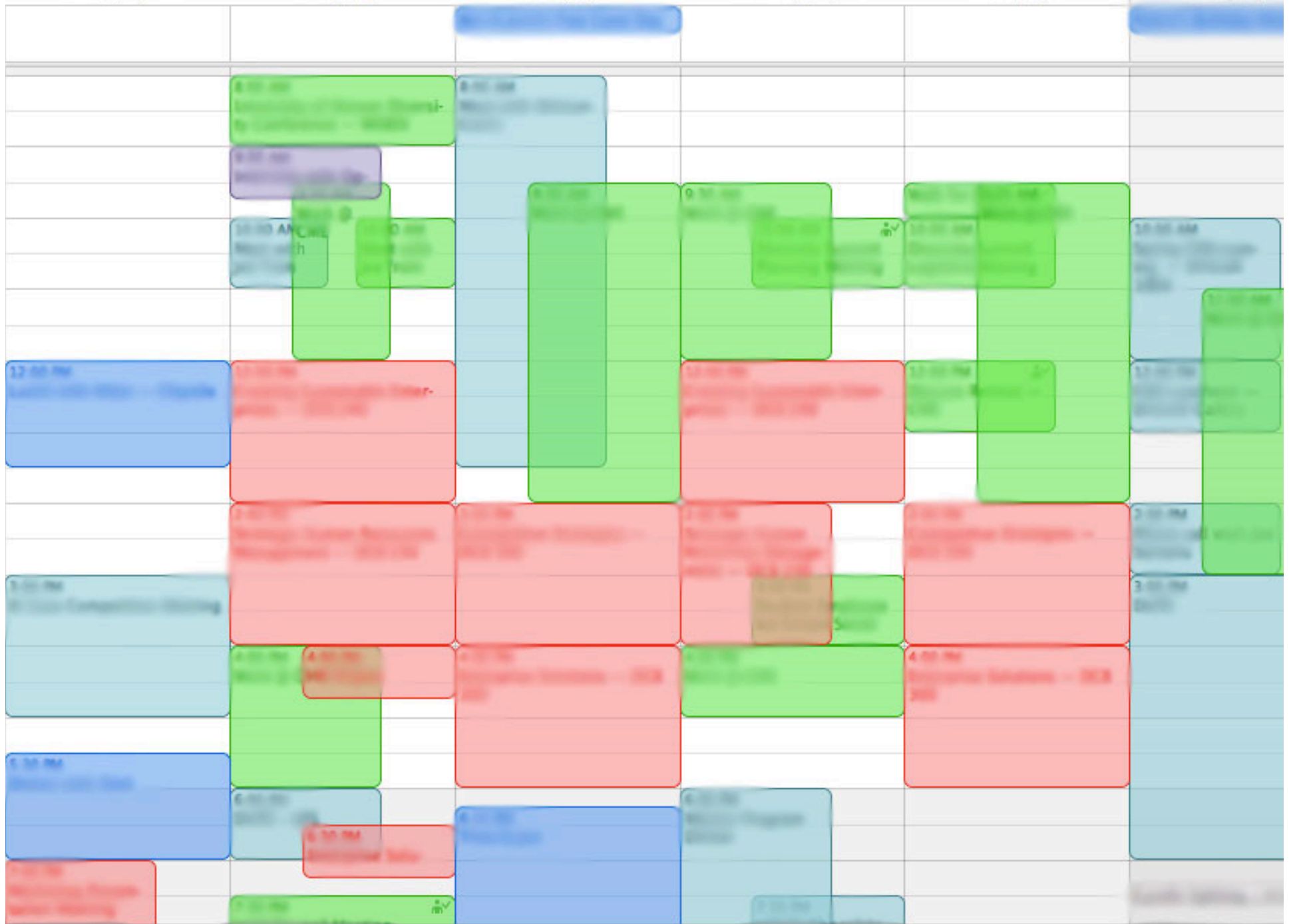

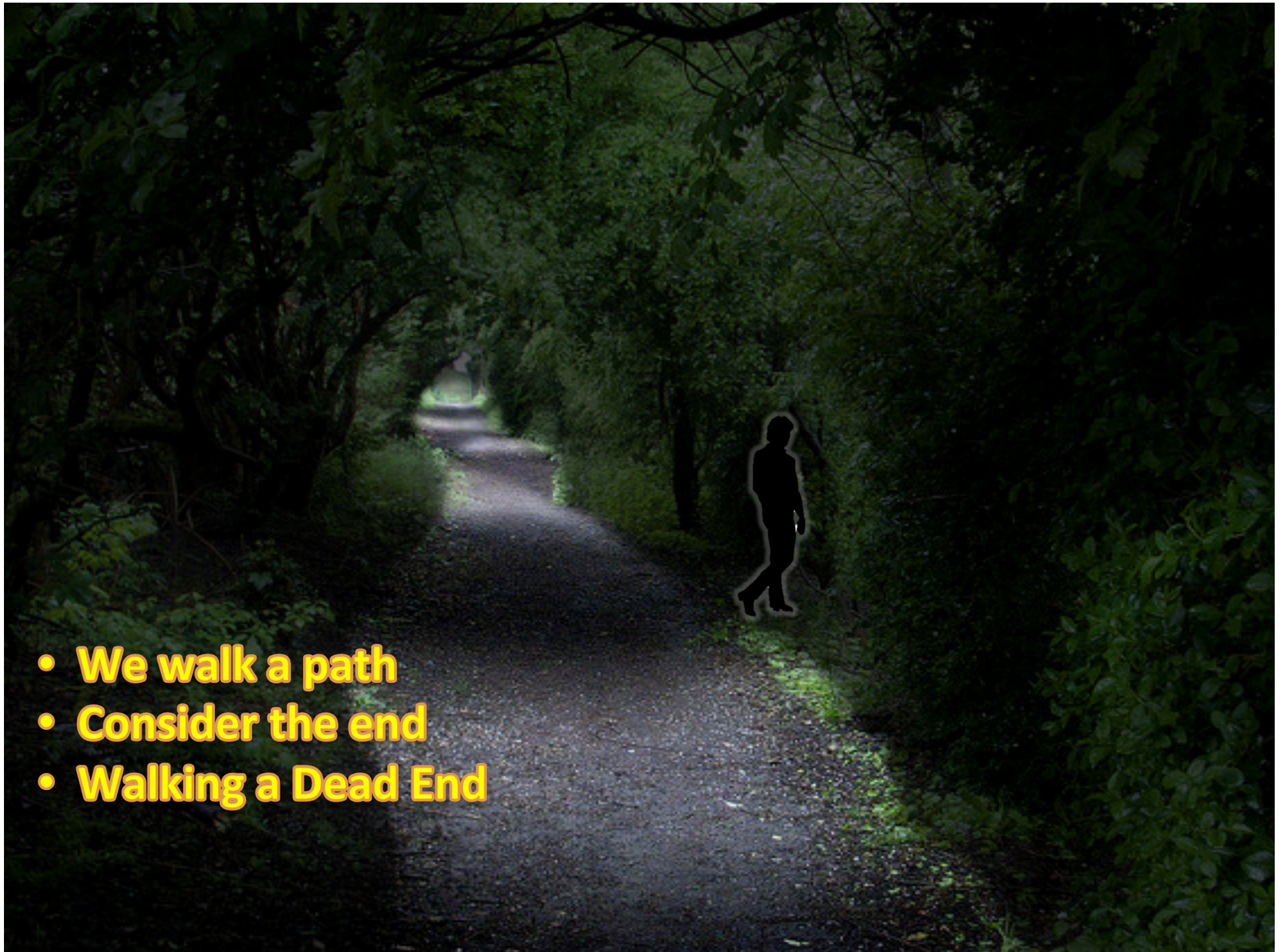
I John 1:6-9
