


THE OBSESSION ISN'T NEW

- 1 Peter 3:4 warns against the danger of putting too much emphasis on outward appearance.
- God created men and women to be attractive to each other.
- In particular, it is God's will to find your mate handsome or beautiful (Ecc. 9:9, Prov. 5:15–20). This is a frequent feature of the poetic language from the Song of Solomon (5:10–16, 1:16, 1:10, 4:7, 6:4–9, 7:1–9).
- The Bible candidly speaks of the beauty of many people (Gen. 29:17, Deut. 21:11, 2 Sam. 11:2, Esther 2:7).







SO, WHAT IS TRUE BEAUTY?

- "Charm is deceitful and beauty is vain, but a woman who fears the Lord, she shall be praised" (Proverbs 31:30).
- "But rather by means of good works, as befits women making a claim to godliness" (1 Timothy 2:10).
- "But let it be the hidden person of the heart, with the imperishable quality of a gentle and quiet spirit, which is precious in the sight of God" (1 Peter 3:4).
- "For the Lord takes pleasure in His people; He will beautify the afflicted ones with salvation" (Psalm 149:4).
