





A high opinion of oneself.


Self-conceit.

8:13 – The fear of the Lord is to hate evil; pride and arrogance and the evil way and the perverse mouth I hate.




Probable reasons God feels strongly about pride

2:16 - For all that is in the world – the lust of the flesh, the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life – is not of the Father but is of the world.




Probable reasons God feels strongly about pride

- 2. It can destroy one's life.


Proverbs
