



IT MUST START WITH LOVE

- "We know love by this, that He laid down His life for us; and we ought to lay down our lives for the brethren" (1 John 3:16).
- "Beloved, let us love one another, for love is from God; and everyone who loves is born of God and knows God" (4:7).

- "By this will all men know that you are My disciples, if you have love for one another" (John 13:35).
- While this might sound like a flowery approach to take, real love is choosing to care about somebody even if you are not initially driven by affection.





PRACTICALTIPS ON MAKING FRIENDS

- Ask about somebody's "life story" hometown, career, hobbies, etc. People love being interviewed!
- Be helpful and available (Galatians 5:13).
- Dig deeper into what makes a fellow Christian strong who influenced them, circumstances of conversion, etc.
- Cut out the excuses!
- Be accessible.
- Do not be afraid to be proactive.
- Be careful not to present yourself as one-dimensional or a perpetual victim. Pity is a terrible foundation for friendship.
